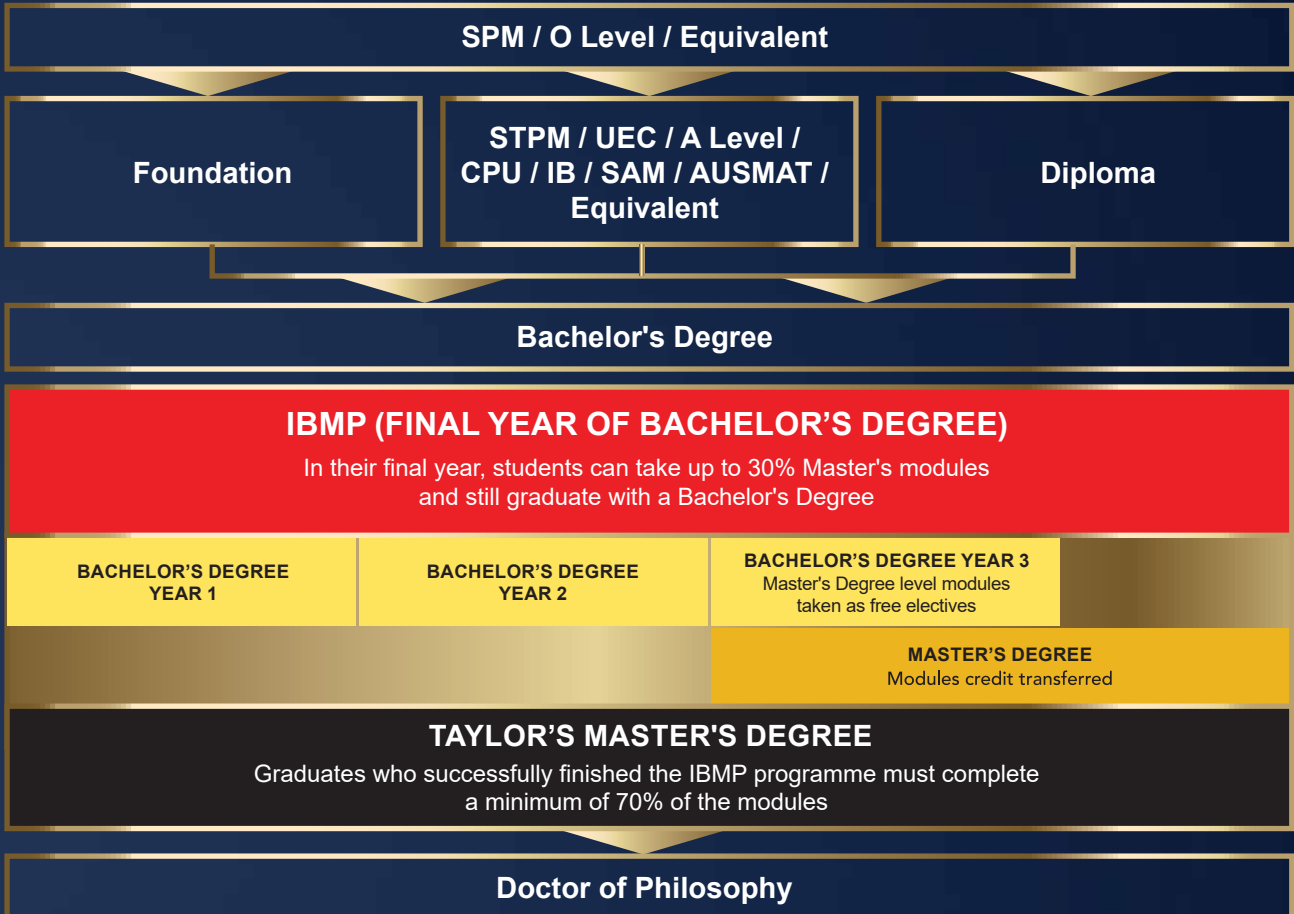

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

(I) To enrol in Master's level modules during your final year of a Bachelor's Degree, you must meet the following criteria:

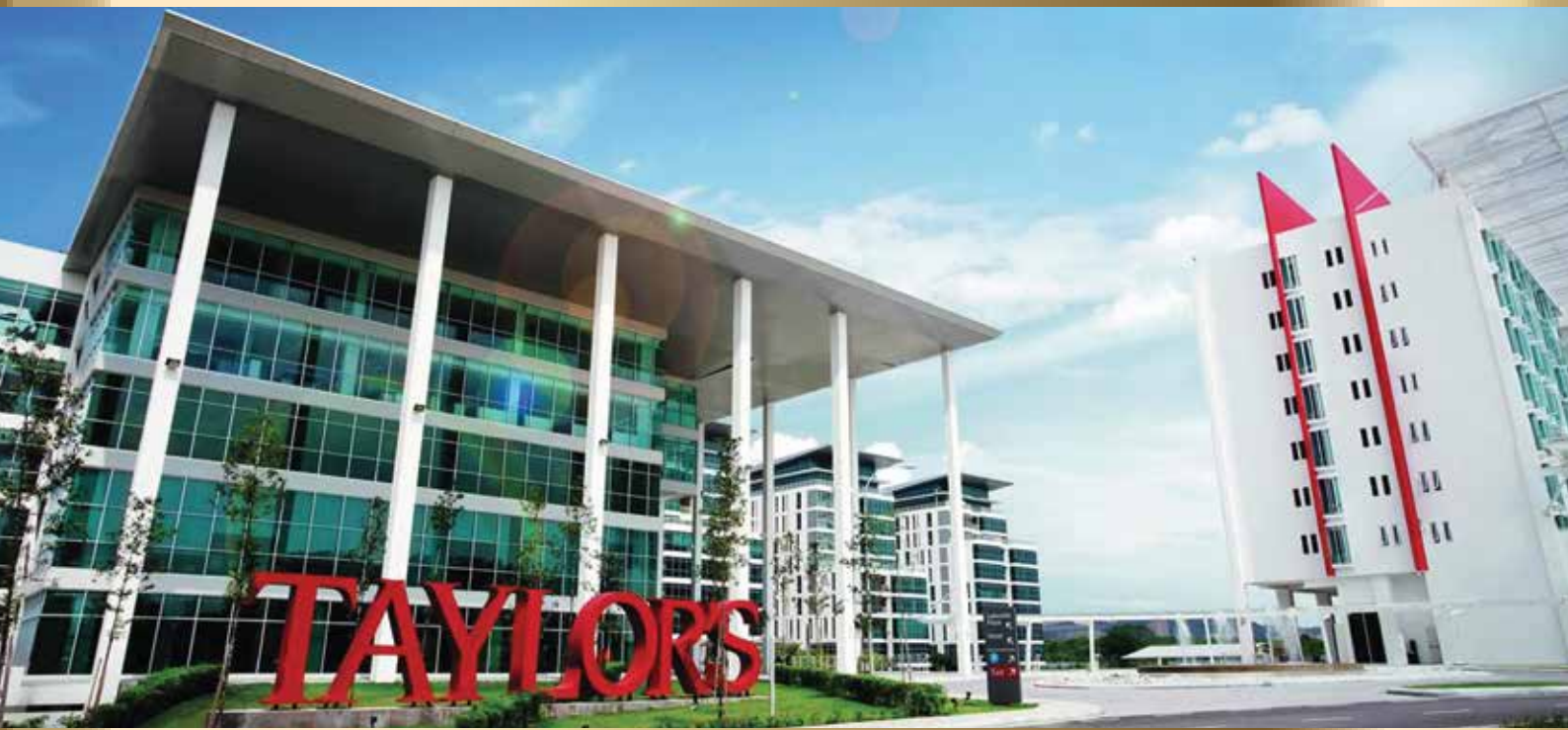
Be a final-year student in selected Bachelor's Degrees

Have a minimum CGPA of 2.50 upon enrolling

(II) After completing your Bachelor's Degree, the entry requirements for a Master's Degree apply for admission into the programme. Credit transfer eligibility for the selected Master's Degree depends on:

A maximum of 30% credit transfer from total graduating Master's Degree credits

Obtaining at least a Grade B in Master's modules completed during the Bachelor's Degree
